ORDER

S.O.1015(E)- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 86 of the Information Technology Act 2000 (21 of 2000), the Central Government hereby makes the following Order, namely:-

- (1) This Order may be called the Information Technology (Removal of Difficulties) Order, 2002.
 (2) It shall come into force at once.
- In section 25 of the Information Technology Act 2000 (21 of 2000) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), in sub-section (1), for clause (c), the following clause shall be substituted, namely: "(c) failed to maintain the procedures and standards specified in section 30:"

(c) funded to maintain the procedures and standards speen

- 3. In section 40 of the said Act, -
 - (i) the word "then" shall be omitted:
 - (ii) for the words "the key", the words "that key" shall be substituted
- 4. In section 42 of the said Act, in sub-section (1) the words "to a person not authorized to affix the digital signature of the subscriber" shall be omitted.
- 5. In section 63 of the said Act, in sub-section (1), for the word "Chapter" the word "Act" shall be substituted.
- 6. In section 89 of the said Act, in sub-section (2), for the brackets and letter "(m)" the brackets and letter "(n)" shall be substituted.
